DIRECTIONS: GRANULAR WEED CONTROL is recommended only for non-cropland areas, such as railroad rights-of-way and other industrial areas. The application of 200 to 300 pounds per acre usually results in a non-productive condition for a period of a year or more. The duration of non-productivity is dependent upon the rainfall, the type of soil and other conditions. Apply GRANULAR WEED CONTROL as furnished using a seed spreader, fertilizer spreader, shaker-type applicator or any other equipment which will distribute the product uniformly over area to be treated.

To control annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, apply at a rate of 200 to 300 pounds per acre; on smaller plots, 0.5 to 0.68 pound per 100 square feet. Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep-rooted perennial weeds are present. To obtain best results, apply to the ground where it will be absorbed by the roots. Applications early in the season have been found to give results superior to applications made later in the season. This product may, however, be applied at any time of the year. Maximum effectiveness in arid regions is obtained when application is made just prior to the rainy season.
